

Lacrosse Young Officials Award

Costs & Criteria



The Lacrosse Young Official Award (YOA) is aimed at young people aged 14-19. The course is a combination of practical and theory sessions designed to equip the Young Official with the necessary skills and a qualification that will allow them to officiate at POP lacrosse.

Following the completion of this Award the Young Official will be directed towards officiating at various POP competitions, starting with low level events such as local and regional POP tournaments, and leading onto some being selected to officiate at high profile events such as the National POP championships and in 2010 at the World Championships POP festival in Manchester.

Course Content: Rules, penalties and running a game of POP lacrosse. Lacrosse officiating skills including positioning, different roles, table officiating. General officiating skills, including game control and officials respect.

The YOA can be delivered by regional development officers, trained tutors (CTS) and qualified teachers (QTS). Delivery is supported by a tutor script and an electronic resource. Each candidate will receive a resource pack including a whistle, lanyard, student resource handbook, student resource quick-flip cards, assessment sheet and a certificate on course completion.
