

Netball Young Umpire Award

Costs & Criteria



England Netball's Young Umpire Award is aimed at young people U18 recommended age 13 – 18. There is no lower age limit and the discretion of the course deliverer is acknowledged when making the decision.

The course combines theory and practical sessions designed to equip the Young Umpires with the necessary skills and qualifications to umpire school and club matches and festivals.

Learning Outcomes: understanding the game of netball and sound knowledge of the rules, gain generic umpiring skills, raise candidate self-esteem, develops teamwork and communication skills and develops a responsibility for self and others.

The YUA is delivered by QTS teachers (who have netball knowledge) after attending a 2 ½ – 3 hour Orientation Workshop delivered by a trained England Netball tutor. Assessment Fee	£15 for 4 x student assessments (Fee may increase if school not affiliated to England Netball) (Recommended 4 students per 2 hour session)
