

Classroom Launch Assembly

Aim: To inspire and excite pupils for the Rugby Counts Programme

Introduction

Introduce the HSBC Rugby Counts Programme.

- What do you already know about rugby?
- What do you already know about finance and money?

Play Rugby Ambassadors launch video

Organise pupils into teams of seven and give them a team country to represent (choose from the rugby sevens tournament teams)

Ben and Nolli introduced us to the rugby values (TREDS) -

Teamwork, Respect, Enjoyment, Discipline, Sportsmanship

- What were the values?
- What does each mean?
- How are they similar to our school values?
- How may these values be useful with money/finance?

Explain that throughout the programme, pupils who display these values will be awarded a HSBC Rugby Counts Certificate from Ben and Nolli.

Money and Movement Tracker

Introduce the Money and Movement pupil trackers. Give one to each pupil and allow them to look and talk about them with their team. Explain that the tracker will capture all of our learning. Each week we will focus on a different financial theme and rugby skill and you will earn points for the activities you complete. We will all be working towards our own and a class saving goal.



Team Talk

Explain that throughout the programme, pupils will work in their teams, and within the classroom there will be a big focus on teamwork and collaboration. One way we will do this will be through team talks.

- What are you most excited about?
- What would you like to learn?

Ask the children to complete the launch page in their tracker, discussing this with their team.

Take feedback
