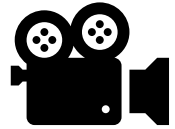

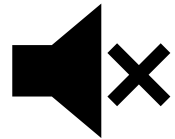

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Dorset Leadership Academy part of the BSc (Hons) Sport Management & BSc (Hons) Sport Coaching courses.

RELAYS team gain volunteer hours from Dorset Leadership Academy events and through the School Games and SSP competitions/events.



Partnership working to achieve CYP priorities. Dorset Leadership Academy is part of the AP's strategy. Funding accessed from DfE Volunteer Leaders & Coaches funding and the DfE Extension funding targeting young people from lower socio-economic backgrounds.



Dorset Mind contribute to each strand in the leadership programme through their 5 ways to wellbeing workshops. We have also worked together to introduce Wellbeing Mentors in each secondary school.



Sovereign Housing support the leadership programme by funding a new leadership award 'The Sovereign Award'. The award targets young people from lower socio-economic backgrounds through a personal development journey and community projects.



Public Health Dorset and the School Nurse Team promote the leadership programme and help to evidence the impact of Bronze Ambassadors and secondary Young Ambassadors to promote 60 minutes of physical activity.



YST Leadership, Coaching and Volunteering programme supports various strands in the leadership academy – Young Coach Academy, Girls Active:Stepping up for Change, Girls Mentoring.

FAGFSP pathways – Game of Our Own.



The leadership programme supports students on BTEC courses to achieve their volunteering hours and to lead workshops at Dorset Leadership Academy events. In return they can access coaching qualification bursaries.
