

Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 The prize draw is open to open to all schools in the UK.
- 1.2 There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this prize draw.

2. Prize Draw Period

- 2.1 The prize draw opens at 00:01 on Tuesday 3 April 2026 and closes at 00:01 on Sunday 14 June 2026. Entries received after the closing time/date will not be entered into the prize draw.
